

## Department of Curriculum and Instruction: State and Federal Programs

## Title 1A Private/Non-Profit School Services

Since Federal dollars are allocated by factors related to a geographical areas, it is the responsibility of public schools to consult with private or non-profit schools (PNPs) that may be serving students that live within the geographical boundaries of the local school district to provide them with an equitable share of the federal programming. Students who are residents of the Imlay City Schools district, attending a private/non-profit school are eligible for Title 1A supplemental services, on an equitable basis with students attending Imlay City Schools.

By May/June of a school year, Imlay City Schools Title 1A Director/Director of State and Federal Programs, will send a letter to private/non-profit schools, inviting their participation in a Title 1A service meeting. In Imlay City, this letter is sent to the Imlay City Christian School. A meeting will be held between the administrator from the Imlay City Christian School and the Title IA Director/Director of State and Federal Programs from Imlay City Schools. At this meeting, a Comprehensive Needs Assessment will be conducted.

A meeting between ICS and ICCS will include agenda items including: date of meeting, MDE consultation form for the provision of services, eligibility determination, the establishment of what services will be provided and how students will be served, establish program goals and expectations for a program evaluation, and establish provisions for any supplies and materials needed.

ICS, specifically the Title IA Director/Director of State and Federal Programs, will complete, in collaboration with the ICS Business Director, the Title 1A component for the Consolidated Application process.
