

Department of Curriculum and Instruction: State and Federal Programs

Written Procedure to Evaluate Title 1, Part A Programs Annually

State and Federal Programs are required to be evaluated annually for effectiveness and impact on achievement. A yearly program evaluation will be conducted using the MDE-Approved Evaluation Tool. Not every facet of the program must be evaluated each year.

Process

- The School Improvement Team, with guidance from the Title IA Director/Director of State and Federal Programs, is responsible for conducting the Title IA Program Evaluation per written procedures.
- The School Improvement Team will confirm that the Title IA initiatives are aligned with the School Improvement Plan.
- The annual program evaluation shall include the following five (5) parts: impact, readiness, knowledge and skills, opportunity, and implementation with fidelity.
- Each school will use the results of a Title IA program evaluation to revise the Title IA Plan.
